## **ADMISSION POLICY**

Applications for registration and admission are accepted in the month of December or as per the directions issued by the Director of Education, but registration does not guarantee the admission.

Admission and assignment to a particular section of the class is reserved entirely to school authorities. Admissions are as per the guidelines of the Directorate of Education.

The application for registration/admission form shall be accompanied by the photocopies of documents like child's date of birth certificate, Aadhar Card/Residence Proof, Caste Certificate, Transfer Certificate etc. The documents in original to be shown at the time of admission. We accept the date of birth certificate issued by Municipal Corporation or Anchal Panchayat. Hospital certificate will not be accepted. A student coming from an affiliated and recognised school should produce a T.C. counter signed by the Directorate of Education with a clear mention of date of birth. Date of birth and name once registered will not be altered. A child must be 3+ by 31st March of that year for admission into Pre-School (Nursery) class, 4+ by 31st March for Pre-Primary, 5+ by 31st March for First and so on.

Parents must declare that the address of the residence, as indicated in the application where from the child will be going to school is correct. Our school has been following neighbourhood policy, if they shift their residence beyond the area decided by Management of S.G.H.M. School, it will be within its right to revoke and cancel the admission of their ward after completing the Academic Session.

## SCHOOL OFFICE HOURS

The office will remain open on all working days (except Second & Fourth Saturdays and public holidays) from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm but public dealings will be from 8:00 am to 12:00 Noon only. The admission number of the student should be mentioned clearly in case of any communication with the office. Certificates of any kind will be issued only on / after the third working day following the submission of application.

## PARENT TEACHER MEETING

Parent Teacher Meeting are held 4-5 times in an Academic Session. The classes will be off for the students on that day but they will come along with their parents in proper school uniform according to the time schedule given to them by their respective class teachers. Parents are requested to make it a point to attend the same for the benefit of their ward.

### **PROMOTION POLICY**

The General Criteria for promotion is that a pupil has grasped the subject matter of his/her present class sufficiently to follow the subject in the higher Classes. Continuous assessment of daily application of work and discipline will be taken into account for promotion to the next class. The minimum passing marks in each subject will be 33%. If a student of Class V & VIII fails to attain 33% marks in each subject will be eligible for **Re-Examination** in all the failing subjects. student could the **Re-Examination** does А who not pass or not appear in the Re-Examination will be placed under Essential Repeat (ER) and will be held back in the same class during the next session. According to the CBSE & DOE norms it is mandatory for all the students to have 75% attendance during the academic session, failing which he/she will not be eligible to appear in examination (Mid Term & Annual Examination). Marks for the attendance will be allotted and added in the Internal Examination according to the Table given below, as per the DOE guidelines vide their Order mumber DE 5/2/212/Exam/16-17/Part-1/717-727 dated 7/10/2022.

### SCHOOL RULES & REGULATION - PART I -WHAT TO DO...

- \* Students must come to school in proper neat and tidy school uniform with well polished shoes.
- \* Students must observe punctuality and regularity in attendance and arrive at the school before the bell is rung.
- \* In case of late arrival or absence, students, must bring a written explanation from the parents in the Almanac. Student's name will be struck off the roll if he or she is absent without leave for two weeks.
- \* Obey the class leader/monitor in the absence of a teacher, to help in maintaining discipline and order.
- \* All students should maintain peace and tranquility in classrooms for reasons of academic ambience.
- \* Sikh students are not allowed to cut or trim their hair, if found, strict action will be taken against him/her.
- \* Sikh boys must wear turban from class VII onwards.
- \* In case a student finds an unclaimed article within the school premises, the same should be handed over to the class teacher.

- \* Students should take proper care of their uniform, books and other articles. School will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
- \* In case a student observes someone damaging any school property, it should be brought to the notice of the class teacher or the V. Principal.
- \* Students are expected to keep the classroom and the school campus neat and clean and all their belongings in a tidy manner.
- \* Since Sri Guru Harkrishan Model School is a Co-ed school, students are expected to behave well and bring a good name to the school as a whole and protect its social reputation.
- \* Students are expected to behave in a courteous manner. They should address their teachers with due respect and politeness.
- \* Students should be encouraged to take part in extra curricular activities as grades will be awarded for the same.
- \* Once back home, attend to your home-work, assignments given by the subject teachers.

## SCHOOL RULES & REGULATION - PART II WHAT NOT TO DO......

- \* As per Traffic Rules (Motor Vehicles Act) students below 18 years are not permitted to drive vehicles and it is very risky on Delhi roads which almost leads to fatal accidents. No student is allowed to come to the school on a self-driven two wheeler or a car, if found the vehicles will be impounded by the School Authorities.
- \* No student will break any norms in terms of turn out, uniform and personal hygiene.
- \* Students are advised not to neglect home work, assignments etc for their own sake.
- \* Students should not be irregular in attendance, or misbehave with any teacher or student, as such acts could justify dismissal from the school.
- \* Parents are not allowed to see their children during the school hours without permission of the V.Principal.
- \* Children who are ill should not be sent to school to attend the class, or take the tests.
- \* Students should not be found carrying money or costly articles such as, electronic toys, video games, cameras, smart watches etc to the school.
- \* Carrying cell phones to the school is totally prohibited.
- \* Girl students are prohibited from wearing any kind of jewellery like golden, silver or artificial.
- \* Girl Students should desist from applying mehendi or other make up.
- \* Students should not leave the school premises during school hours without a sound reason and the prior permission of the Co-ordinator/V.Principal.
- \* Students should not scratch or make any mark on desk, walls or doors of the school. Any damage done to the school property will be remitted by the offender.

### NOTE TO THE PARENTS

- 1. Personal memo page in duplicate should be carefully filled in by the parents at the beginning of Academic Session. Change of residence and telephone number or any other information should be notified to the school immediately.
- 2. Parents are requested to look into the school Almanac of the child daily. Remarks made in the Almanac should be seen, counter- signed and reply the notes regularly. Children should be sent regularly and punctually to the school in **neat and clean proper school uniform.** Please see that your ward notes the homework daily in his / her Almanac.
- 3. If your child is not assigned homework for some time, the V. Principal should be contacted.
- 4. Private tuitions are discouraged in the school. The school teacher is not allowed to give tuitions to the students of this school. Parents should guide and coach their ward regularly.
- 5. Do not criticize the teacher/school in the presence of your child. If you have a legitimate complaint, meet the V. Principal without fear of reprisal.
- 6. Teach your child dignity of work. He should be taught to keep his bag and room tidy, polish his own shoes, carry his own bag etc.

- 7. As the medium of instruction is English, children should be helped to follow their classes easily by a certain amount of regular conversation in a cultural manner in this language at home.
- 8. Ensure that your ward does his/her work independently.
- 9. Make sure that your ward reaches school by 7:50 am.
- 10. Please see that you have deposited monthly fee of your ward in time.
- 11. Habitual late comers will be marked absent, fined and even sent back home. Students short of 75% attendance will not be allowed to take examination. Their name can also be struck off the rolls.
- 12. Cultivate the habit of reading in him/her, give him/her good books and occasionally see what type of books he/she reads.
- 13. Parents of Sikh students should wear turban whenever they visit the school to encourage their ward/wards to do the same, as they are the role model for them.
- 14. Please ensure that your ward carries his/her lunch with him/her as no lunch will be accepted in between the School hours.
- 15. If your ward is on Medical Leave, the Medical Certificate along with Fitness Certificate should be submitted after recovery. The Medical Certificate and Fitness Certificate should be of MBBS Doctor.
- 16. Once the child enters the School thereafter no half day or short leave will be granted.
